Response:- Batheaston Parish Council as all other Parish Councils in B&NES, was asked by B&NES to undertake surveys and submit reports on sites identified by them for consideration under their 'Strategic Housing Land Allocation (SHLAA) and their Character Assessment initiative. Specific pro-formas, with questions dictated by B&NES had to be filled in and submitted by Mid December. The exercise required the mobilisation of all Councillors in a very short time frame to arrange site visit, carry out survey work, prepare written documents and illustrations, edit documents and make them available for this Council's consideration before they are submitted to B&NES by the 21st of December. This obligation was put at very short notice and has necessarily taken up a lot of private personal time by all Councillors and because of this the intended Neighbourhood Plan programme has had to be shelved until a more appropriate time.
