 - 9.1.2. The advantage of doing so by working with a charity, to raise funds and to cover some of the costs of these projects, was highlighted. The Clerk

- reported that he has made contact with Trustees of a local charity, as requested at the November Council meeting.
- 9.1.3. Nevertheless Committee members felt that the Precept may need to be increased and asked the Clerk to present this as an option for the forthcoming Council discussions.
- 9.1.4. It was recognised that the Council would have to make clear to residents what they would be getting for their money. Councillors discussed the desirability of developing a plan for the next year and beyond.
